Financial aid applications **must be submitted a minimum of one week before the start of class**. Funds will be removed from the student's account and payment is due in full if, for any reason, the student is determined ineligible to receive financial aid.

How to Apply for Financial Aid

Check List

- Request** a Personal Identification Number (PIN) (pin.ed.gov)
- Complete** the online FAFSA (fafsa.ed.gov)
- Complete** the Financial Aid Request form
- Complete** the Financial Aid Verification Worksheet (front and back pages, if needed)
- Submit signed** tax returns (*i.e.* If the FAFSA is for the 2011-12 school year, turn in 2010 taxes.)
- Submit Additional Documents (must be provided within 3 days (if requested))
